Scholarship Policies

The scholarship committee will be comprised of Lloyd C. Bird High School Band Booster members. The committee will include two parents of Junior band members, two parents of Sophomore band members and one parent of a Freshman band member. No parent of a Senior may serve on the committee. One Sophomore parent will agree to serve two years and be the chairperson for the second year. The Lloyd C. Bird Band Boosters President will appoint all committee members. A parent should serve no more than two consecutive years. Duties of the committee chairperson include:

- 1. Printing the appropriate number of applications and insure delivery to the band director(s) for distribution.**
- 2. Verifying applicant's fundraising quotas and good standing with the school and band.**
- 3. Acquiring band director's ratings before committee meets.**
- 4. Providing copies of each application and worksheet for each committee member. (Be sure to assign numbers and white-out the applicant's names and record them separately.)**
- 5. Providing certificates to the recipients to be presented at the annual concert.**
- 6. Providing the treasurer with the names and social security numbers of the recipients, the schools address where they will be attending and the amount of each scholarship so that checks can be issued.**
- 7. Provide a copy of the recipients' names to the school office and guidance office.**

The Committee is encouraged to award as many substantial scholarships as possible. The Lloyd C. Bird High School Band Booster Executive Board will notify the scholarship of the total dollar amount available for scholarships. The amount per scholarship will be \$500.00. The committee does not have to allocate the total amount allowed for the scholarships. It is the right of the committee to not award any scholarships if there are no qualified candidates. If either occurs, the allocated money will remain in the scholarship fund.

Purpose: To recognize outstanding members of the Lloyd C. Bird Skyhawk Band for their contributions to the overall Band program, including musicians and Color Guard members.

The Student:

- a. Must be in good standing in both the Skyhawk Band and at Lloyd C. Bird High School.
- b. Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- c. Must be a graduating senior entering a college, university or technical school for the following year.
- d. Applicant must use this money for the purpose of higher education and must have been accepted as a full time student at an accredited college, university or technical school.
- e. Current application forms must be submitted to the band director(s) by the annually announced deadline. **LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

The Scholarship:

- a. The Lloyd C. Bird Band Booster Scholarship Committee will decide the number of recipients.
- b. Scholarships will be paid directly to the institution of higher learning on behalf of the recipient and NOT the individual.
- c. Consideration will be based on band program participation, performance, service, and essay. The director(s) will rate performance, participation, commitment and attitude.
- d. No consideration will be based on the college, university, or technical school the applicant will be attending or what course of study the applicant will be pursuing.
- e. Scholarship awards will be presented at the annual concert.
- f. These are not need-based scholarships.
